



# MET EWS VAL DI FASSA TRENINO

CANAZEI (TN, ITALY), 23<sup>rd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2021

## PROTOCOLS AND OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

**A.S.D. FASSA BIKE** affiliated with the FCI has identified the measures and safety behaviours to regulate the event “**MET EWS VAL DI FASSA TRENINO**” which is going to take place on **23<sup>rd</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021** in Canazei (TN, Italy).

The event is a mountain bike enduro race, part of the “*EWS – Enduro World Series*” Circuit. Val di Fassa will host the first and second main races of this circuit in the 2021 season on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> June.

On all three days of racing, the event is going to begin at **08.30** and will end at or about **17:00**.

The race venue will be divided in three zones: White Zone, Yellow Zone and Green Zone (as per attached map).

To ensure a 1m distance between human beings only a limited amount of people will be allowed to enter the race venue. This number is based considering 4sqm per person. In all areas involving a physical activity we have increased the distance to 3m between human beings considering 10sqm per person.

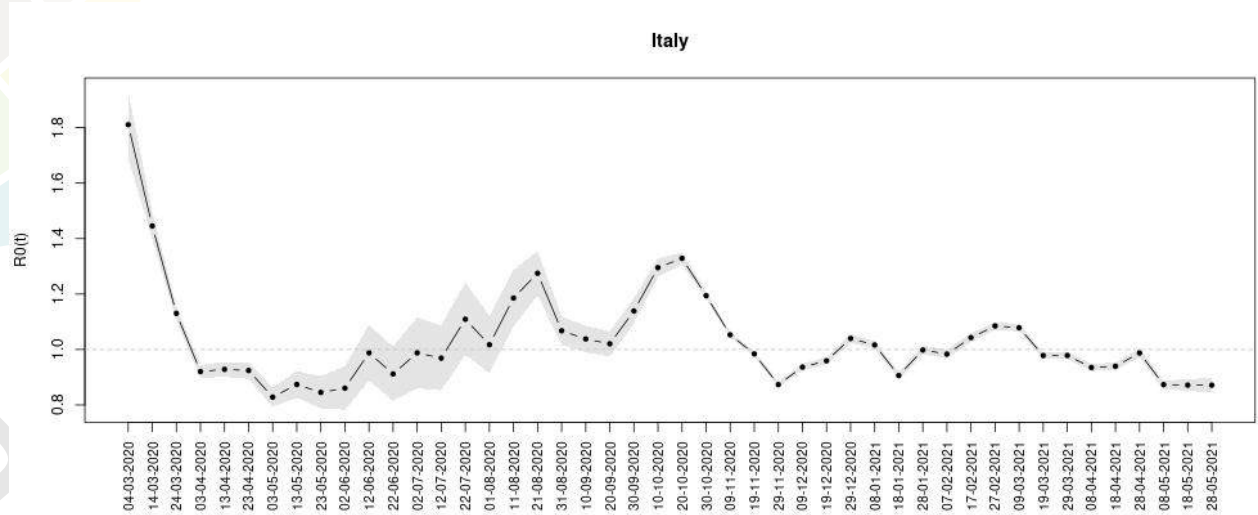

## WHITE ZONE

The White Zone is located in the upper part of Strèda Roma in Canazei, at about 50m from the Yellow Zone (start/ finish of the race). The White Zone is nothing but a section of a road closed to public traffic and anyone without the proper pass.

The White Zone, which covers about 1,000sqm, will be accessible to those accompanying the races who are not sport operators as well as the organizational staff and the mechanics.

Within the White Zone it is enforced a 1m distance between people. At any given time, the max number of people allowed inside is 200, considering at least 4sqm per person.

The entrance to the White Zone will be controlled and managed by one of the members of the Anti-Covid Committee who will perform the following tasks:

- Measuring the body temperature of every person;
- Retrieval of the COVID self-certification;
- Filing-in the list of people entering the zone (name, surname and telephone number) to be kept for at least 15 days after the end of the event;
- Ensuring people wear the safety mask.

At the entrance of the White Zone sanitification tools will be available and a trash can. Both at the entrance and within the White Zone, there will be special signs to remind people of the correct behaviour to be kept once inside.

## YELLOW ZONE

This zone is accessible only to sport operators, the organizational staff as well as the professionals (e.g. Red and White Cross, journalists, speaker, etc.) identified by the EWS Local Committee to support the events.

The Yellow Zone is made of three sub-zones clearly marked:

- **The start/ finish area – in Piazza Marconi and the nearby City Hall of Canazei.** There lies the stage as well as all the offices related with press, timing and the jury. This area covers about 1,250sqm and at any given time, the max number of people allowed inside is 150, considering a lot more than 4sqm per person.
- The **Team Pro Area** located in the lower part of Strèda Roma, at about 100m from Piazza Marconi and nearby the First Aid station. This area covers about 1,800sqm and at any given time, the max number of people allowed inside is 350, considering 4sqm per person and about 40 team vehicles.
- The **Team non-Pro Area** in Streda del Piz located in the parking lot nearby the water amusement-park “Dolaondes” which is about 300m from Piazza Marconi. This area covers about 7,600sqm and at any given time, the max number of people allowed inside is 1,600, considering 4sqm per person and about 100 team vehicles.

Every person within the Yellow Zone will have to wear the safety mask at all times.

For all three sub-zones there is a confinement area where subjects showing Covid-19 symptoms are going to be isolated: a small portion of a grass field isolated from the other areas and nearby the First Aid station. A gazebo and a seating area will be made available. This section will be managed and under the supervision of the Race Doctor.

### ENTRANCE TO THE YELLOW ZONE

At the entrance of each sub-zone of the Yellow Zone sanitification tools will be available and a trash can. Both at the entrance and within the White Zone, there will be special signs to remind people of the correct behaviour to be kept once inside.

At any given time, there will be at least one member of the Anti-Covid Committee patrolling the area who will perform the following tasks (always wearing a safety mask and gloves):

- Measuring the body temperature of every person using a termo-scanner. Should the body temperature be higher than 37.5° (F) the entrance will be forbidden.
- Retrieval of the COVID self-certification. **We remind that the Self-Certification is mandatory for the racers to be admitted to the races.**

- Filing-in the list of people entering the zone (name, surname and telephone number) to be kept for at least 15 days after the end of the event;
- Handing-out passes to access the zone. There will be various passes, in order to identify the role executed during the events.

Both at the entrances and within each sub-zone of the Yellow Zone, there will be special signs to remind people of the correct behaviour to be kept once inside.

**No WCs are located within the Yellow Zone**

### **Details about the sub-zones within the YELLOW ZONE**

**Secretary:** SPACE IN THE OPEN, NEARBY THE CINEMA “MARMOLADA”, LOCATED IN THE LOWER PART OF STREDA ROMA.

N° staff: 8 - N° work-stations: 5

#### NOTEs

- **The staff will always be wearing a safety mask and gloves;**
- The local committee is going to make available gels, sanitification products as well as waste containers;
- The work-stations will be seated positions, located with enough safety distance from one another and be equipped with plexiglass barriers.

**Area Team Pro:** IN THE OPEN, LOCATED IN THE LOWER PART OF STREDA ROMA

#### NOTEs

- **Everyone is going to wear a safety mask**, except for the racers during warm-up exercises;
- Every team will have full control of their allocated area in so far social distancing is involved, sanitification and trash management;
- This area will be open between 07.00 and 20.30 every day. After 20.30 it will be fully empty with nobody allowed until 07.00 of the next day;
- There is going to be one vehicle entrance/ exit with a person manning the gate

**Area Team Non-Pro:** IN THE OPEN, LOCATED IN STREDA DEL PIZ

N° Team vehicles: 100 - N° Sport Directors: 50 - N° Racers: 400

NOTEs

- **Everyone is going to wear a safety mask**, except for the racers during warm-up exercises;
- Every team will have full control of their allocated area in so far social distancing is involved, sanitification and trash management;
- This area will be open between 07.00 and 20.30 every day. After 20.30 it will be fully empty with nobody allowed until 07.00 of the next day;
- There is going to be one vehicle entrance/ exit with a person manning the gate;
- On the opposite side of that entrance there will be a gate with a person manning it which will allow people to walk in and out (also with their bikes).

**Jury and Race Director room:** CLOSED SPACE WITHIN THE TOWN HALL BUILDING

N° staff: 6

This room has got one access door as well as a window door to ensure proper ventilation.

NOTEs

- **Everyone is going to wear a safety mask;**
- The local committee is going to make available gels, sanitification products as well as waste containers.

**INDICATIONS FOR PRELIMINARY PROCEDURES**

Racers' card verification is not required. A single representative for each team will communicate his/ her team's non-starters at the secretary desk and will collect the race pack (already prepared by the organization) with the race numbers and technical information of the race.

The teams/ racers meeting will take place online – there won't be any in-person attendance required.



## Other locations within the YELLOW ZONE

### Starting/ finish area and stage

The whole area of departure - arrival is cordoned off and has only one entrance/ exit in Streda Dolomites (near the entrance to the municipal building). This gate will be manned by a person provided by the local committee at all times and only eligible people will go through it.

In the vicinity of the entrance/ exit gate there will be another one reserved for journalists who will use the press room inside the municipal building; the press room is very large and with the possibility of being ventilated thanks to the presence of several doors and windows. The workstations will be spaced apart and there will be plexiglass barriers to divide them.

On competition days, there will be a third entrance/ exit gate located on the opposite side of the square of the above-mentioned gates. This gate will be used by athletes waiting to access the stage for their race to begin as well as the racers at the end of their race to leave the stage. This gate will also be manned by the staff of the C.O.

Access to the stage in the starting/ finish area will only be granted to members of the Jury, the timekeepers and the speaker.

### NOTES

- Social distancing of 1 meter between people will be guaranteed. The speaker will be 2 meters away from the rest of the staff;
- **Everyone must wear a mask**, except for the speaker;
- The organization will provide sanitizing gels and waste containers.

### Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will take place inside the "Marmolada" ski school in Canazei. Inside the structure, windows and doors will be kept open to allow constant ventilation. Access to this building will only be granted to the 3 awarded athletes of each category, the prize delivery officer, one competition judge and a representative of the O.C. Accredited journalists will be allowed to enter the building in small groups in order to maintain social distancing.

### NOTES

- **Everyone is going to wear a safety mask and gloves;**
- Social distancing of at least 1m between one another;
- The organization will provide sanitizing gels, gloves and waste containers.

## GREEN ZONE

(i.e., the space entirely dedicated to metabolic activity)

The Green Zone includes 4 Special Stages (P.S.) built on footpaths inside the forest in the surroundings of Canazei (TN). The P.S. are called Titans, Ciasates, Animal House and Tutti Frutti.

All departures and arrivals of the P.S. will be cordoned-off as per protocol in the 50 meters before the starting line and up to 50 meters after the finish line.

The starting area of the P.S. "Titans" is in Ciampac, near the ski slope that goes down to the village of Alba di Canazei (a small town within Canazei municipality), while the arrival area is near the end of the above-mentioned ski slope.

The starting area of the P.S. "Ciasates" is located near the forest road reaching a locality called "Ciasates". The arrival area is located in the meadows near the Avisio river.

The starting area of the P.S. "Animal House" is located in the middle of the ski slopes of "Belvedere" not far from the mountain rifugio "Gherdeccia". The arrival area is located near the end of the ski slope in locality called "Lupo Bianco".

The starting area of the P.S. "Tutti Frutti" is located at "Col Rodella" near the mountain rifugio "Des Alpes". The finish area is located near the end of the ski slope that arrives in Canazei.

In the green area, only athletes, race judges, staff at the organisation's departures and volunteer staff are allowed in.

Except for the athletes, all must remain in the area only for the time necessary to carry out their duties.

It is mandatory to wear a mask except for athletes who in any case must wear eye protection (goggles or visor).

Entrance to the green zone is allowed just few minutes before the race of each racer begins.



## **COVID-19 SUSPECT CASE MANAGEMENT PROTOCOL**

### **BEFORE AND AFTER ENTERING THE EVENT AREA**

- If an infection is suspected and symptoms occur, stay at home/ accommodation and call the health number 112.

### **AT THE EVENT AREA**

- Affected person immediately goes to the rescue tent;
- The doctor/nurse at the first-aid tent on duty, immediately takes further action;
- The Covid-19 Doctor is notified and take the contact details of the concerning person;
- The Covid-19 Doctor reports the suspicion to the authority and coordinates other measures;
- The Covid -19 O.C. Lead shall identify the whereabouts of the concerning person and implement hygiene measures more intensively;
- Change shift schedules/service classifications for affected internal/external staff;
- All those involved in the vicinity are immediately informed of the situation;
- If possible, all persons who are in contact with the person concerned are to be found.

### **PROCEEDINGS OF CONFIRMED CASE (POSITIVE TEST)**

- Follow the instructions of the Authority;
- Immediate self-isolation in the sense of a domestic quarantine:
  - Don't leave the apartment;
  - Strict adherence to hand, cough and squeeze hygiene;
  - In the case of acute medical care, 112 is to be informed by telephone about the positive Covid-19 test;
  - No participation in the event.
- The organizer must be informed of the positive test;
- The Covid-19 Doctor and the Covid-19 O.C. lead coordinates further measures

### **Contact persons**

- Immediate self-isolation in the sense of a domestic quarantine;
- Don't leave the apartment;
- Follow the instructions of the Health Authority.

### **CRITERIA FOR DEFINING CONTACT CASES AND THEIR MANAGEMENT**

- Contact persons (i.e., persons suspected of infection) are persons with a defined contact to a confirmed case during the time period of contagiousness (i.e., contagious contact)
- Contagiousness exists 48 hours before the onset of the disease (i.e., onset of symptoms) up to 10 days, after onset of the disease or in the case of asymptomatic cases 48 hours before up to 10 days after sampling, which has given a positive test result.
- In the case of severe or persistent symptoms the infectious period may take a while.

### WHO IS CONSIDERED A CONTACT PERSON?

- Persons living in the same household;
- Persons with conversational contacts under 2 meters and more than 15 minutes without a FFP2 mask
- Individuals who have been together with a positively tested person in enclosed space at a distance of less than 2 metres and 15 minutes or more without a FFP2 mask
- Persons who, regardless of distance, are highly likely to be exposed to relevant concentrations of aerosols (e. g. celebrations, sports indoors)
- Persons in direct contact with secretions (e. g. coughing)
- Persons with direct body contact (shaking hands)
- Direct neighbours in aircraft or other long-haul means of transport
- Health personnel who cared for persons without adequate DPis who tested positive.
