COVID Safety protocols

At the Enduro World Series Tweed Valley, we're here to have a great time, while keeping all fans, teams, staff and athletes safe

Visitors to the event are welcome to come and watch, visit the Festival Village and enjoy the racing. We only ask that you care for each other and the athletes around you

We've put some distance up between the Team Paddock and restricted access only to the staff and athletes that need it. You can still watch all the action, just a few meters away from the athletes themselves

The back offices and event production areas will be accessible only by those wearing Green and Blue wristbands

Media shuttle buses are only accessible with Green or Blue wristbands

Masks need to be worn whenever you're inside, including in ALL shuttles

We've got plenty of nice outdoor space so spread out and give each other 2 meters distance when walking around the Festival Village or watching from the side of the course

Keep your hands clean at all times. Use the sanitizer stations located around the Festival Village

SANITISER STATIONS

Please use our hand sanitiser stations when you arrive and throughout your visit.



FACE COVERINGS

Please wear a face covering when inside enclosed spaces at EWS, including the beer tent (except when eating or drinking)



KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Please maintain a safe distance from others during your visit, 2 metres is recommended. Please be patient if you need to join a queue.



SIGNAGE & INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow any signage placed around the venue, including one-way systems etc.

Event Zones

Green Zone

The Green Zone is the official race course

Access Rights:

- All racers
- Yellow, green, blue and red wristbands
- Any rider with a number plate
- Media, volunteers, medics and course officials

Red Zone

The Red zone is an area dedicated only to professional teams and EWS racers

Access Rights:

- Green, blue and red wristbands

Yellow Zone

The Yellow zone is an area dedicated to international professional racers only

Access Rights:

- Green, blue, yellow and red wristbands

White Zone

White zones are all public zones in and around the event

Access Rights:

- All event attendees (restrictions on Yellow bands)
 - No wristband control measures
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Wrist Bands

Red	- EWS Racers
Yellow	- International Elite Athletes travelling with Exemptions
Blue	- Official Media
Green	- Official Staff
No wristband	- Local visitor, spectator, amateur racers



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Elite Athlete Exemption

If you have entered the UK and are using the Enduro World Series Elite Athlete Exemption Status, please complete the form sent to you by the Enduro World Series Athlete Manager.

Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff must only carry out essential duties at the event and not spend time in any white zones

Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff must follow UK government pre-departure and pre-booked day 2 test requirements

In addition, Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff are strongly advised to carry out daily lateral flow tests for a minimum of 5 days after arrival in the UK

Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff must remain where possible in isolation, avoiding the use of lifts in their hotels and other restricted indoor spaces. Do not use shared toilets where possible (use en-suite) and eat separately from other guests where possible

Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff must not enter any shuttle buses at the event with other users

Schedule 3A athletes and essential staff must minimise contact with other athletes and event staff
