Hello Racers and Managers,

Below are the Vittoria EWS-E Tweed Valley race day details / updates:

START LISTS

Start List is posted on the [event page](#)

Start from the podium stage in the Festival Village (behind the white marquee registration tent) . [MAP](#)

Please arrive at the stage at least 10 minutes before your scheduled start time to collect your timing chips.

Remember to apply your 5 bike marking stickers. Commissaires will make an initial check of each bike before the start area to ensure the correct security stickers are fitted in the correct places. You will need to have enough time for the check to get to the start line in time for your allotted start time.

Race Start (RS)

- The time you are assigned to roll out from podium stage

Penalties for late Race Start is the same as the EWS

Loop Start (LS)

- This is the time you must leave Start Loop 2 and Loop 3.

A late start will incur a penalty

Penalties for late Loop Starts are the same as missed time checks in the EWS

Liaison Time Check (LTC)

-Racers MUST check in BEFORE each Special Stage Start. A late LTC will incur a time penalty.

This is the time which appears on the Start List

Penalties for Late Liaison Time Checks will be 5 seconds per minute late

Stage Start (SS)

- Your start time on each Special Stage is 6 minutes AFTER your LTC.

This time does not appear on the Start List.

Penalties for late Stage Starts are the same as the EWS.

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Technical Assistance is only permitted in the Race Paddocks.

BATTERY STORAGE / CHARGING STATIONS

Racers can bring their replacement batteries and/or chargers (plus tools / food / gear) to the white tent next to Fox . Batteries should be labeled with the stickers provided in your race package.

30 minutes has been allocated for battery changing / charging .

FEED ZONE

Feed Zone will be set up at the white Outdoor Provisions tent in the Festival Village (opposite white marquee registration tent)

Following will be available : [Outdoor Provisions](#) nut butter and bars, homemade flapjacks, and water.

EMERGENCY DISPATCH

Course marshals and officials can also contact medics by radio

ONBOARD CAMERAS

Reminder that chest mounts are not permitted.

On board cameras must either be worn on peak / visors or affixed with a breakable mount.
