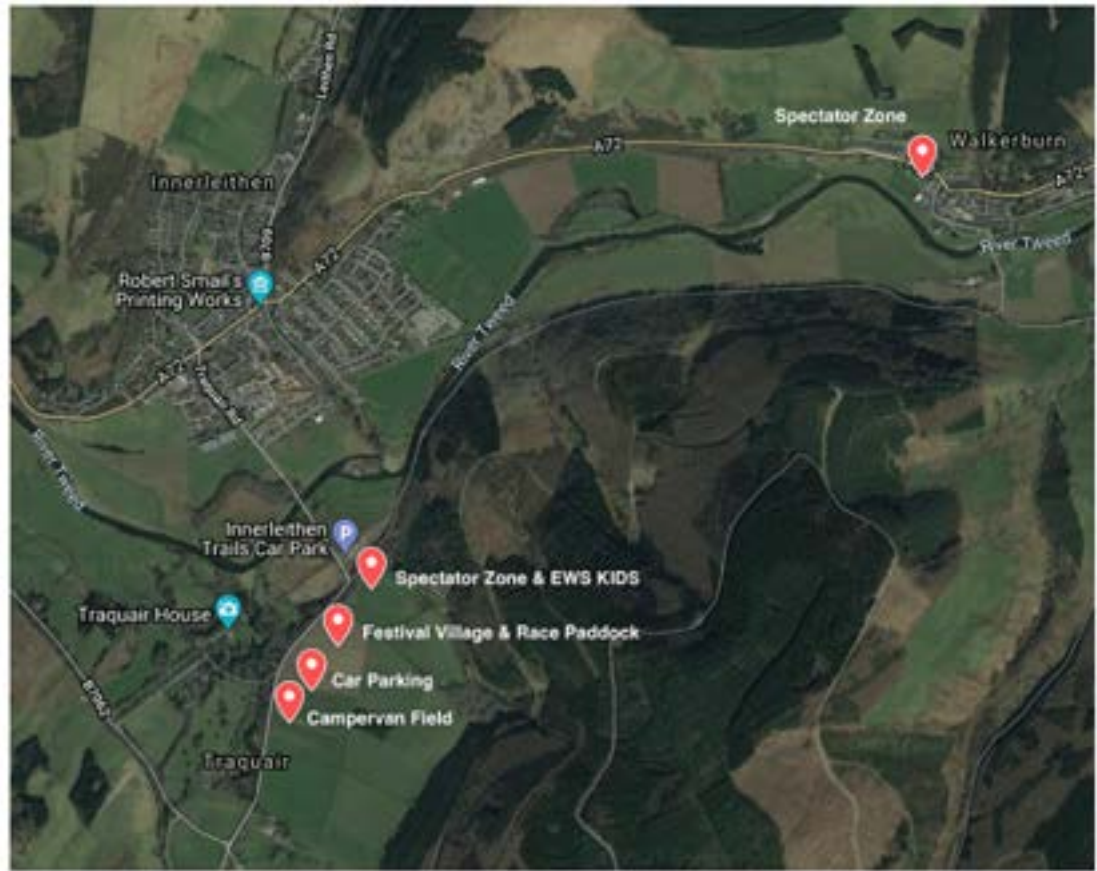



	<p><b>TRAINING</b></p> <p>Once the courses are announced May 27, all race stages will be closed for riding until training.</p> <p>Race stages are closed during official training to all but racers, accredited media and official EWS-E Team staff. All riders on course during practice must have plates on their bikes. Any rider training without a plate or outside the official schedule will be disqualified.</p> <p>Racer will be limited to 1 training run on each race stage. To manage congestion on the tracks during training, each group (EWS and EWS-E100/EWS-E50) will have assigned times for each stage. Details will be published closer to the race date - refer to Schedule.</p> <p> <b>Safety Protocol: riders stopping on track to check lines or pushing up to session sections must do so from outside the tape.</b></p>
	<p><b>UPLIFTS</b></p> <p>No uplifts (shuttles or chairlifts). All liaisons to be pedaled during both training or race days.</p>
	<p><b>TIMING CHIPS</b></p> <p>Timing system: SPORTident AIR+ system</p> <p>Each racer will be issued two transponders (the second unit provides backup in case of loss or a crash). One transponder should be worn on each wrist.</p> <p>Timing chips will be collected in the finish area of the race. Racers who withdraw or do not complete the race should return the chips to the timing tent in the finish area.</p>

#### EWS-E

Technical assistance is only permitted in the Technical Assistance Zone.

Location and access to Technical Assistance Zone during the race will be confirmed once the course map is published.

#### EWS-E100 and EWS-E50

Outside assistance is permitted.

#### PLUG POINTS

There will be plug points for battery charging in the TAZ. (between Bosch and Yeti/Shimano) Batteries / chargers are left in the TAZ at the rider's own risk.

## START ORDER and SEEDING

### EWS-E

#### Seeding

Riders will be seeded based on the final 2021 EWS-E Series Rankings. Other relevant race results may be considered.

Racers will be seeded fastest first.

#### Start Intervals

Riders in the EWS-E will have individual preassigned start times for all the Special Stages. 30 second start intervals.

### EWS-E100 and EWS-E50

EWS-E100 and EWS-E50 use a fastest first format.

Racers will be assigned a start position for the first stage based on the information in the "Self Seeding" section of their EWS Rider Profiles ( 1 Super Fast | 2 Fast | 3 Good | 4 Pure Fun ) .

EWS-E100 and EWS-E50 racers can also request to be paired up with teammates / friends for the start (even from different categories).

Once EWS-E100 and EWS-E50 racers leave the start, they are not required to remain in the original start positions for the balance of the stages.



## START LIST and START PROCEDURES

List of registered riders published on the event page : "Participating Rider" tab/menu

Start List will be published the day prior to the race.

Any racer who has not collected their race plate by the check in deadline will be not be added to the Start List.

### EWS-E Pro

Racers will have preassigned start times for every Special Stage.

Late racers may be given the following penalties:

up to 5 minutes late = 1 minute penalty

5+ minutes late = 5 minutes penalty

Any racers arriving at the start of a race stage later than 30 minutes after their specified start time will be assigned a DSQ for the race and should not complete any other stages.

Racers MUST check in BEFORE each Special Stage Start.





Penalties for late Liaison Time Checks will be 5 seconds per minute late.

### EWS-E100 and EWS-E50

To minimize congestion on the tracks, the race start will be staggered. Each EWS-E100 and EWS-E50 racer will have an individual assigned time to leave the start / Paddock.

Once EWS-E100 / EWS-E50 racers leave the start, the racers will need to complete the balance of the Special Stages in order. But there are no specific Liaison Time Check or Loop Start times for the EWS-E100 or EWS-E50 races. Rather, EWS-E100 / EWS-E50 riders will have a specific time

The Race Director is authorized to give additional penalties that are not listed in the Rulebook in the case of a rider who fails to respect the other riders, the spirit of the sport, the environment or the organization.

Protests and complaints regarding the race, results, behaviour of the other racers and any other sort of issue must be presented to the Race Director or Chief Commissaire within 15 minutes from the posting of the results.

### PROTECTION RULES

Racers must wear a full face helmet (either fixed or detachable chin piece) on all race stages. Detachable chin piece can be removed for the liaison and Power stages.

The rules apply to both training and race days.



### FILMING RIGHTS AND REGULATIONS

#### FILMING AND BROADCAST RIGHTS

As Play Sports Network Limited ('PSN') are the exclusive licensee of the EWS-E events organised by Enduro Sports Organisations Limited ('ESO') we request that the following regulations are adhered to for other electronic media videographer / video journalists (incl. videographer / video journalist for digital platforms as for traditional TV broadcasters / channels):

- All websites / promoters / digital platforms etc, including for the avoidance of doubt any TV and linear broadcasters / channels as appropriate, (together, the "Platforms", and each a "Platform") are to share with PSN and ESO / PSN the identities of any videographers / video

journalists that will be attending any EWS stage prior to any filming taking place - limited to three videographers / video journalists per Platform.

- Filming of races, practices and pits are allowed subject to the following limitations:
  - a maximum of 4 cumulative minutes of footage is permitted of race days of pro-races (meaning the Men's and Women's Enduro World Series and EWS-E Series), for the avoidance of doubt there shall be no cap on the use of footage shot during practices.
  - filming with a drone is not allowed, save for any Local Organiser (as defined below) contracted directly with ESO for any relevant EWS event;
    - Any such drone footage captured by the relevant local organiser accredited by and contracted with ESO ("Local Organiser") for an EWS event may be utilised by ESO / PSN in their sole discretion.
- Use of content pool allowance (based on Team tier) and footage of races and practices is subject to the following limitations:
  - Footage is to be used for media / editorial purposes only, subject to the following:
    - Advertorial / commercial use of the footage by Platforms, or by official EWS race teams are permitted only with the prior written consent of ESO / PSN.
    - In any case, Licensee shall not include any promotional and/or advertising message from an advertiser that might suggest the existence of any form of partnership between this advertiser and the Events and/or ESO/PSN if such is not the case.
- Any on-board footage captured by an athlete present at any EWS-E event is subject to the following limitations:
  - ESO / PSN may use any on board footage on request;
  - ESO shall retain all rights to on board camera footage for the top 5 Men's and top 5 Women's riders in each of the pro races (meaning the Enduro World Series and EWS-E Series race days).
  - Any edit of on board footage provided to you by ESO may not be released until after the publication of the official highlights and any use of the same shall direct viewers to the official highlights.
- If you wish to feature any of the official highlights, you are only permitted to do so by embedding them directly from the ESO or Global Mountain Bike Network ("GMBN") YouTube account.
- Subject to the limitations listed above, footage may only be published on a Platform's own media platform with the above crediting in place, and subject to the following:
  - Sub-licensing of footage to 3rd parties only with the explicit prior written consent of ESO / PSN;
- For the avoidance of doubt, the rights granted to use any race footage or dedicated highlights of any EWS event shall cease one year from filming. At the end of the one year term, any such footage shall be deleted and publications shall be removed from the relevant Platform if a subsequent extension/renewal on media rights is not agreed. Usage periods for advertorial/commercial use of the footage shall be determined separately by ESO/PSN at the time of request.





#### ONBOARD CAMERAS

On board cameras must either be worn on peak / visors or affixed with a breakable mount. Chest mounts are not permitted.
